Mike Quigley's page recently received a write-up in the Vancouver (B.C., Canada) *Sun* which mentioned that Mike's Five-O page was named one of the top 5% of Web sites. Some of the features on Mike's Five-O page include a .WAV file of the theme music, an episode-by-episode guide to what he calls "goofs, oddities, and trivia," and, graciously enough, a big plug for the Iolani Palace Irregulars and the group's fanzine, *Pau Hana*. Mike has also compiled lists of composers and directors of episodes, and also prints the *Hawaii Five-O* FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions file).

Todd Witteles' page has been declared "Weird" by Internet Underground Magazine, and is a recipient of their "Weird Award" and mention in the pages of the newsstand publication. Headers for each section on Todd's page sound like orders given by McGarrett. Todd lists TV stations around the world which currently run Five-O in syndication. He also has the Official *Hawaii Five-O* Drinking Game, information on the Iolani Palace Irregulars, graphics, sound files, and more.

Mark Musante and Julie Helmer go the satire route with a hilarious "episode guide" to the series' "lost 13th season," and a page for websurfing Five-O fans to enter original limericks inspired by the series. Their "Quick Jump"[tm] season finder takes a fan right to whichever season's episodes they want to browse through. And they also host the "Red Cross Supplemental" (or: why the Five-O team's health insurance premiums are so high). Mark and Julie have lots of links to other Five-O related Web pages as well as many links to general Hawaiiana.

Through Tim Krell's Five-O Fun Page, a websurfer can take a trip to Five-O locations, beginning at a luxury hotel room where the TV is playing our favorite series. Photographs and descriptions of a variety of sites bring back lots of memories to a browsing fan. The "tour" includes Iolani Palace, the Rainbow Tower Hotel, Kalakaua Avenue, Kapiolani Park, Punchbowl, and more. Comments include examples of episodes the locations were used in.

For those interested in learning about the history and culture of Hawaii, connections can be found through Dan Curran's Three Shields Hawaii, a major Island Internet provider.

## A KILLER GROWS WINGS

**Episode 188 February 5, 1977 Production No. 0561**  
(Summary prepared by Reg Jones)

An Australian entomologist named Weatherby (Bruce Wilson) is spotted by Chadwick (Paul Shenar) as he is studying insect life around the roots of a stand of sugar cane. When he tells Chadwick that there is a rare and dangerous infestation in the field, Chadwick kills him.

Chadwick, it turns out, is the plantation manager for Mrs. Katie Holbrook (Carol Vogel). She is a recent widow who, with Chadwick's connivance, is being convinced that she'll have to sell the place to avoid bankruptcy. "Fortunately," a buyer is at hand -- Vadney (Robert Witthans). Vadney claims to represent a group of mainland businessmen who, he asserts, think it would be fun to own a plantation in the Hawaiian Islands. To allay her concerns, Vadney claims that all the workers would be able to stay on. She reluctantly signs an agreement to sell, and further agrees to let independent appraisers set the price.

When Weatherby's body is discovered, the red soil on his boots reveals that he was murdered in a farming area, not where the body was found. It also yields larvae of an exotic cane borer which could wipe out Hawaii's sugar cane crop if not eradicated before the larvae become moths and disperse. Five-O launches a highly publicized search for the contaminated field.

A worker who observed Chadwick and Weatherby together attempts to blackmail Chadwick. He is killed for his efforts. However, the fact that the worker was employed by Mrs. Holbrook turns McGarrett's attention to her plantation. It soon becomes apparent that Vadney is only a front for Sam Patton (Richard Kiley), an unscrupulous developer. It was Patton who had Chadwick plant the larvae in her cane field so that after the sale, the land would be declared commercially inviable as a plantation. Patton could then buy it for next to nothing and turn it into a site for hotels and high rises.

Eager to find the spot where the larvae were planted, McGarrett has his newspaper and radio cronies issue bulletins saying that the larvae threat is over. In a panic, Patton races to the site and discovers that 1) the larvae are still there and 2) Five-O has tracked him to the spot. The field is torched and Patton is arrested after a car chase through the cane fields.

At the close, Mrs. Holbrook learns that Patton, Chadwick and Vadney are headed for jail and that her plantation is economically viable. She was never in danger of bankruptcy.

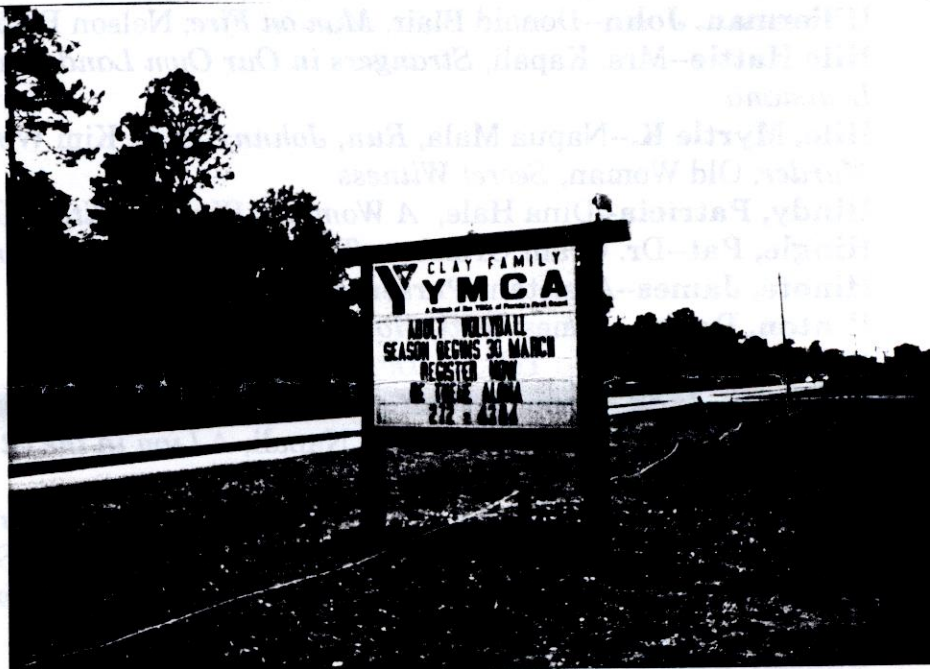

## Speaking of Books . . . continued

The book is scheduled to come out in the fall; I hope it will be timely for the Five-O convention! McFarland's address, for ordering, is Box 611, Jefferson NC 28640-0611. For our overseas members, they also have a U.K. distributor: Shelwing, Ltd., 127 Sandgate Road, Folkestone, Kent, CT20 2BL England. McFarland's US "800" order line is 1-800-253-2187.

There is more to the book, of course, than could be mentioned in their standard catalog blurb allocation: there are sidebars throughout the episode guide which give background information, anecdotes, and analysis. Listings in the episode guide also include composers for each episode. There is a final chapter reaching some conclusions about the series and bursting a persistent myth.

Appendices include a list of episodes in order of production and a glossary of Hawaiian words and phrases used in the series.

Is the book expensive? At \$45, yes, it is. However, this is not the typical trade paperback you buy in the bookstores [e.g., Allan Asherman's *Star Trek Compendium*], which is only glued together and falls apart after four or five run-throughs. This is a library reference book, with a tough, durable library binding -- it'll be around long after I'm gone! The book is also printed on acid-free paper, so it is not likely to deteriorate over time, as many popular-press books do.

Let me take this opportunity to thank the fans who gave me input and who are quoted throughout the text of the book. Let me also thank everyone for all the support and encouragement I've received on this project. To paraphrase an old beer commercial, "This book's for you!" -- Karen Rhodes
